

IMPORTANT NOTICE TO EASTERN MARKET VENDORS:

Per the Eastern Market Legislation, selling may only take place at Eastern Market with the written approval of the market manager. To satisfy this requirement, all Eastern Market vendors must register each season in the Marketspread vendor management portal. If you have issues registering, we are willing and ready to help you. Just reach out to any of the Eastern Market management team members and they can support you.

Please understand that if you do not register in Marketspread, we will no longer be able to accept payments from you and if you set-up at Eastern Market without registering in Marketspread, you will receive a Market Violation Notice (for each set-up instance). Finally, and critically important, per the Eastern Market Legislation, after three Market Violation Notices a vendor will no longer be permitted to set-up at Eastern Market. If a vendor still chooses to set-up after receiving three Market Violation Notices, that action will be considered unlawful entry onto District of Columbia property and the set-up vehicle will be ticketed and towed.

This important notice is being posted on our website on Saturday, October 30th. Additionally, on the 30th, we are disseminating the aforementioned message to all vendors via email, it is being posted at the cashier's table, and throughout the market. In 14 days, on Saturday, November 13th, this requirement will be enforced as outlined above. If you are not yet in the system for the Fall season, please reach out to us ASAP so that we can get you registered and avoid a Market Violation Notice.
